

Medical Terminology Training - Volume 1 provides 150 medical terms with their definitions in both English and Spanish text. The electronic textbook for this course also includes audio models in both English and Spanish. Interactive, scored practices follow the presentation of the terms. An interactive, scored final includes multiple rotating versions. An index for the medical terminology provides links to “Pronunciation in English for Medical Professionals”^{*} for contextual examples and further practice.

This product was created per a request from the Educational Fund (SEIU – UHW & Joint Employer Education Fund) to provide an online, interactive, electronic resource to help employees improve their skills and move up professionally. For example, mastery of medical terminology in multiple languages is one of the requirements to become a professional interpreter. The audience for this product is composed of working professionals in the medical industry with variable shifts who need a resource available on a 24/7 basis on multiple platforms (PC’s, Macs, Chromebooks, laptops, tablets and smartphones) with interactive text and audio. This first volume is in Spanish and English. Additional languages will be added later.
